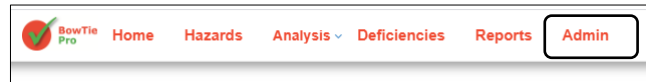


Setup Google Maps in BowTie Pro™ Cloud Edition

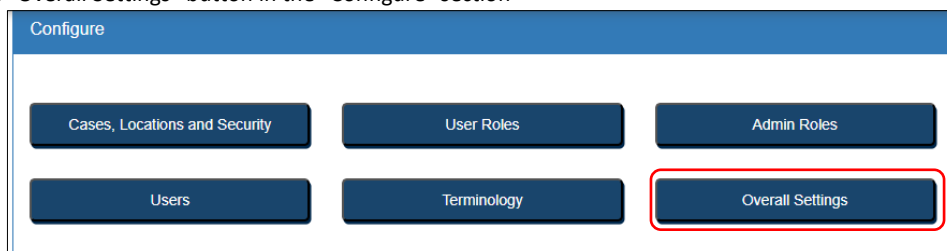
Google Maps functionality allows an organisation that has setup the “Case” data to be used for geographical sites to display the overview of the site on the home page. This document describes the process to allow an Administrator to Setup Google Maps.

Procedure

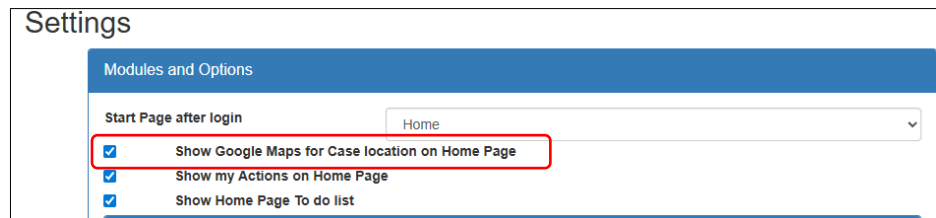
1. Login into the system using your user name and password.
2. Click the “Admin” button at the top of the screen.



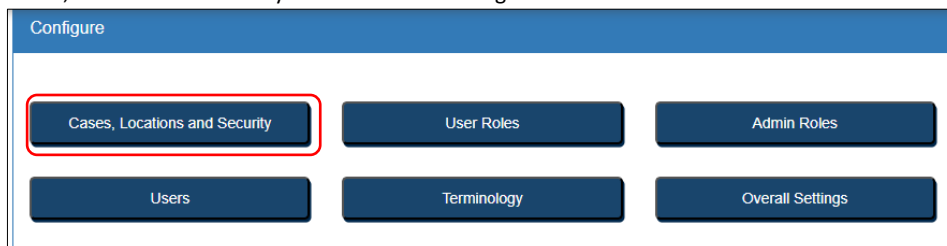
3. Click on the “Overall Settings” button in the “Configure” section



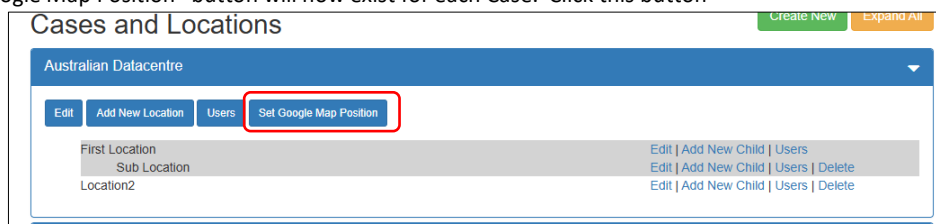
4. Select the “Show Google Maps for Case location on Home Page” checkbox and then press save to return to the Admin screen



5. Click on the “Case, Location and Security” button in the “Configure” section



6. The “Set Google Map Position” button will now exist for each Case. Click this button





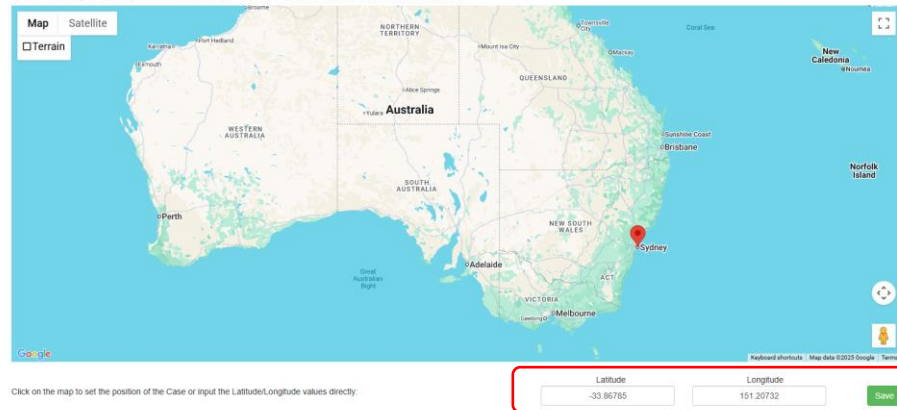

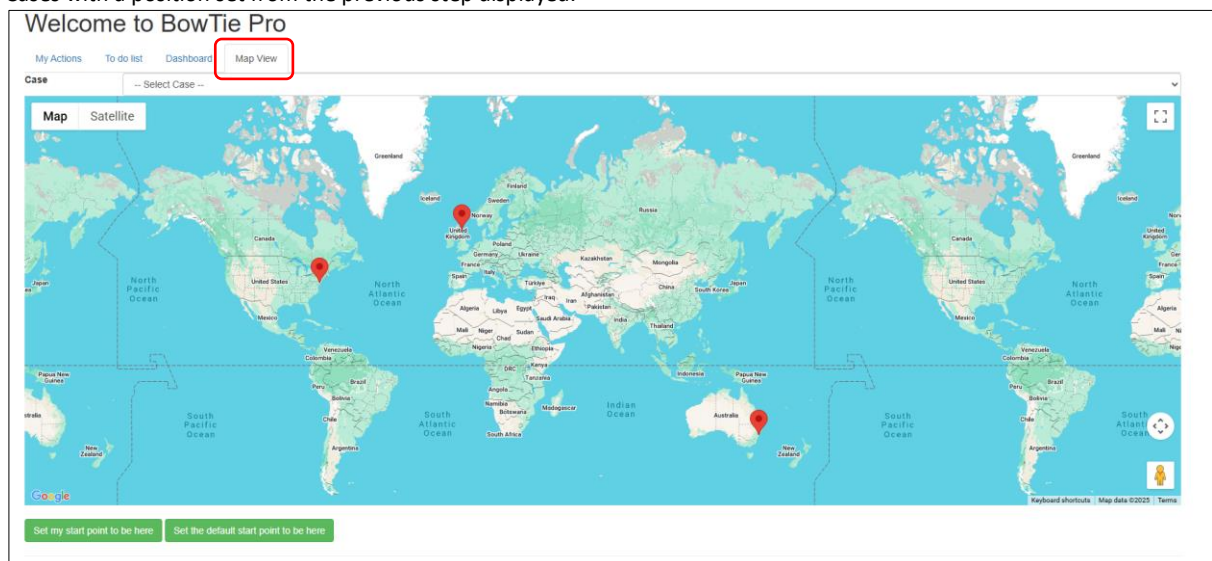

- Click on the map to set the position or if you know the longitude and latitude these can be entered at the bottom next to the "Save" button. Once the correct position is selected press the Save button

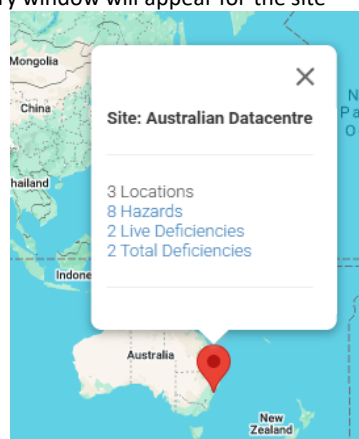
Set Google Map Position for Case : Australian Datacentre



- Return to the Home page by pressing the BowTie Pro logo. A tab called "Map View" will appear and this will have all the Cases with a position set from the previous step displayed.
